JUVENILE FAMILY COURT

The Court finds that pursuant to Education Code Sections 49076(a)(11) and 49077 the release of _____'s student records is necessary and appropriate in the dependency proceedings to protect the health, safety and educational rights of the student for the purpose of 1) compiling the pupil's health and education summary; 2) fulfilling education case management responsibilities; 3) assisting with the school transfer or enrollment of the student and 4) juvenile court dependency proceedings.

It is hereby ordered that the San Francisco Unified School District is authorized and directed to release _____'s pupil records to the following individuals and organizations and their employees and/or agents:

1. County Placing Agency
2. San Francisco Human Services Agency
3. San Francisco Juvenile Probation Department
4. Care Providers
5. Court appointed attorneys for the student
6. Court Appointed Special Advocates for the student
7. San Francisco Unified Family Court
8. Anybody who has been appointed as an educational surrogate or responsible adult for the student
9. San Francisco Independent Living Skills Program
10. San Francisco Guardian Scholars Program
11. Any other individual appointed by the court to represent the pupil's interests.

Pursuant to this Order, all individuals and employees of the aforesaid organizations shall submit written proof to the San Francisco Unified School District that they are authorized to accept _____'s student records prior to the production of the student records.
