**ASSEMBLY BILL 490/MCKINNEY VENTO HOMELESS ASSISTANCE ACT, SUBTITLE VII-B**

Effective January 1, 2004, Assembly Bill (AB) 490, Chapter 862, imposed new duties and rights related to the education of children and youth in foster care (dependents and wards of the court). Reauthorized in January 2002, McKinney Vento, provides federal legislation that addresses the education of children and youth experiencing homelessness in U.S. public schools.

All educational and school placement decisions for foster and transition youth shall be made to ensure that each foster and transition pupil has the opportunity to meet the same academic achievement standards to which all pupils are held, is placed in the least restrictive educational programs, and has access to the academic resources, services, extracurricular and enrichment activities as all other pupils. Education Code (EC) § 48850(a); 42 U.S.C.11431

The new school shall immediately enroll the foster or transitional child even if the foster or transitional child has outstanding fees, fines, textbooks, or other items or moneys due to the school last attended or is unable to produce records or clothing normally required for enrollment, such as previous academic records, medical records, proof of residency, other documentation, or school uniforms. Education Code (EC) § 48850(b); 42 U.S.C. 11432
