Academic Enhancement

Eligible students can participate in pre-selected CCSF courses designed to develop college success skills. Upon completion of these classes, students will earn both high school and college credits. Students are eligible to enroll in a maximum of four (4) CCSF units and seven (7) SFUSD elective credits.

Successful Transition

Students will become familiar with the CCSF Campus and build a support network with students, faculty, counselors, and staff.

Personal Enhancement

Classes and enrichment activities promote critical thinking, self-advocacy, and academic/career planning. Students will participate in college tours, career shadowing, and financial literacy workshops.

Orientation to services

Students are provided intensive educational support services and will also receive valuable information regarding CCSF educational programs and university transfer opportunities.

Multicultural education

Diverse staff and faculty weave a range of cultural perspectives, experiences, and analyses throughout the curriculum. Students' life histories and experiences are placed at the center of the teaching and learning process.

Eligibility

Current or former foster youth in their junior or senior year of high school and entering college freshmen.

High school students must obtain consent from their caregiver and high school counselor.

The Summer Academy will be held from **June 14th through July 22nd**
