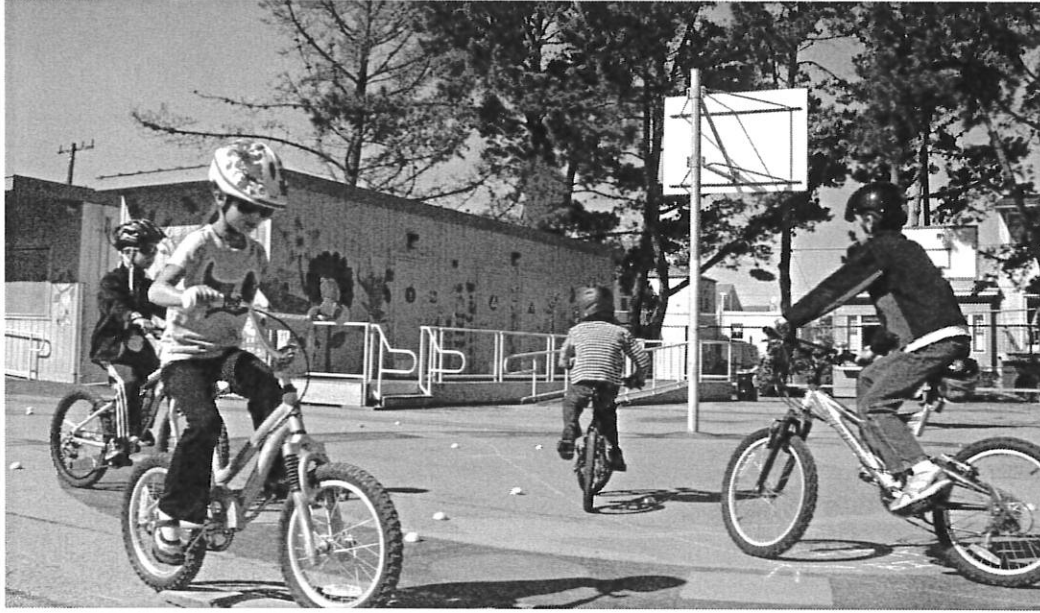

WHAT: SF Bike and Roll to School Week 2017 celebrates the joys and many health benefits of biking or “rolling” to school as a family. The Safe Routes to School Partnership provides <u>incentives</u> and <u>resources</u> to participating schools who sign up to hold an event during the week of April 17-21 st . Hurry! WHEN: Your event can take place from April 17 - 21, 2017 (or if necessary another date). <u>It can be one day that week or a weeklong celebration.</u> Schools may structure the activities in the way that works best for the individual site.				
HOW: Schools sign up at http://sfsaferoutestoschool.org/events/biketoschool . Resources for organizing, networking with other organizers, and training for a successful event are offered once you sign up.				
WHERE: Typically students and their families meet at a location (nearby park) before school starts and they bike and roll together to school. Each school makes sure that students of all abilities have a way of participating. When all arrive to school there is an assembly in the yard or cafeteria at the start of the instructional day.
