SCHOOL FIRST AID SUPPLIES

WHAT? Each school site is responsible for ordering first aid supplies for the 2009-2010 school year. First aid supplies should include the following:

- classroom kit for each class
- field trip kits (back pack)
- yard kits (fanny pack)

HOW? Refer to the attached lists of Classroom First Aid Kits, Office First Aid Supplies, Field Trip First Aid Kits, and Yard First Aid Kits. **Contents, classroom containers, fanny packs and back packs can be ordered and kits can be assembled at the school site.**

WHERE? All supplies can be ordered from the warehouse. **The catalog can be found at www.sfusd.edu on the Warehouse Department web page.**

WHO? School site administrators or designee are responsible for ordering and tracking supplies. Monthly kit inventories are attached for your convenience.

WHEN? Supplies should be ordered as close to the start of the new school year as possible.

- Soap and water is the best method for cleaning wounds. If there is no running water, you may use the antiseptic wipes. **Do not** use hand sanitizer wipes to clean wounds.
