...To provide access to current health information to every school.

Historical Background: The Nurse of the Day Program began in 1991. Many schools in SFUSD do not have a school nurse and may not have access to current, reliable health information.

What is the Nurse of the Day Program?

The Nurse of the Day (NOD) is located at the School Health Programs Department. A nurse is available by phone (between 8:30 am and 4:00 pm) to all schools to respond to health concerns and health questions.

What is the Goal of the Program?

The goal is to provide timely responses and current health information to San Francisco Unified School District employees, parents/guardians, and community based organizations.

Current Status: The program is in full operation daily for all SFUSD schools.

All activities within SFUSD and SHPD are supported by NOD including:

- Emergency/Crisis Response Team
- SAP/SST Program
