The program consists of 2-4 sessions between an adolescent and youth-serving adult, including up to three youth intervention sessions and one optional session with parents or family members. The Brief Intervention program is effective for use with youth who:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have a short history of drug use and low levels of dependence • Experience few problems related to their drug use • Are unsure or ambivalent about changing their use patterns • The program is often used as an alternative to suspension and may be implemented on a mandatory or voluntary basis <p>HOW: Register Below</p>
