Description	<p>WHAT: SFUSD Student, Family and Community Support Department, in cooperation with the California Department of Education will be administering the California Healthy Kids Survey (CHKS) online in grades 7,9, and 11 in randomly chosen classrooms in SFUSD schools during the fall of the 2019 - 2020 school year.</p> <p>Survey Content. The survey asks questions related to local youth health risks and behaviors, school connectedness, school climate, protective factors, and school violence.</p> <p>WHY: SFUSD uses the results of the survey to continue to improve health education programs and support services for students in our district. The CHKS is part of a comprehensive data-driven decision-making process on improving school climate and student learning environment for overall school improvements.</p> <p>WHEN: CHKS will be administered in October and November 2019. The CHKS is administered every other year.</p> <p>NEXT STEPS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • School Health Programs, in collaboration with ETR, will distribute copies of the Parent/Caregiver Notification to your school • Language arts classroom teachers will distribute the Parent/Notification Notifications to the families of the students in their randomly chosen classes. Passive consent (opt-out) is requested of families. Families only return the notification if they do not want their child to participate in the survey. • Further instructions will be sent directly to the school administrator before the start of the survey implementation
