Description	<p>Mayor London Breed announced her "Bridge to Excellence" Scholars Program, which will provide scholarships to highly-motivated graduating high school seniors from low-income and under-resourced communities in order to help overcome financial barriers they face to attend college.</p> <p>The "Bridge to Excellence" Program will award up to two students from each of San Francisco's public high schools with \$2,500 each in scholarship awards. This will be the largest scholarship program run by the Mayor's Office since it began in 2011.</p> <p>San Francisco Unified School District High School Seniors graduating Spring 2019 who can demonstrate a financial need and are the first in their family to attend a four-year college are encouraged to apply. Students must have a cumulative GPA of 3.20.</p> <p>The online application can be found at: https://sfmayor.org/priorities/education. The application window will be open until Monday, April 29, 2019. The Mayor's Office will review all qualified candidates and notify recipients by the end of May.</p>
