Description	During the first semester of the 2018/19 school year, School Health Programs will administer the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) Youth Risk Behavior Survey (YRBS). The mandatory survey monitors priority health risk behaviors that contribute to the leading causes of death, disability, and social problems among students. Here are some key facts about the YRBS:
	 It is administered every other year to a random sample of students in grades 6 through 12 at all middle and high schools. The paper and pencil surveys will require one class period.
	• Our evaluation partner, ETR Associates, will be randomly selected classes, send selected teachers all necessary materials, and work with you and your staff to develop an appropriate administration schedule.
	• ETR will also send you parent consent letters (for grade 6) and parent notification letters (for grade 7-12) in advance of the survey administration, which will need to be disseminated and returned quickly.
	SFUSD utilizes data from the YRBS to define important programming for students as well as to assist with grants to provide critical services. We look forward to your collaboration with this implementation and partnering with you to use the data to assure students are safe, healthy, and ready to learn.
