Description	<p>(1) Immunizations Requirements for TK/K-12th Grade Starting July 1, 2019</p> <p>Starting July 1, 2019 Students Admitted at TK/K-12 need:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Diphtheria, Tetanus, and Pertussis (DTaP, DTP, Tdap, or Td) — 5 doses (4 doses OK if one was given on or after 4th birthday. 3 doses OK if one was given on or after 7th birthday.) • For 7th-12th graders, at least 1 dose of pertussis-containing vaccine is required on or after 7th birthday. • Polio (OPV or IPV) — 4 doses (3 doses OK if one was given on or after 4th birthday) • Hepatitis B — 3 doses (not required for 7th grade entry) • Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR) — 2 doses (Both given on or after 1st birthday) • Varicella (Chickenpox) — 2 doses <p>Students Starting 7th Grade Need:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap) —1 dose (Whooping cough booster usually given at 11 years and up) • Varicella (Chickenpox) — 2 doses (Usually given at ages 12 months and 4-6 years. Please note that the TK/K-12 immunization requirements apply to 7th graders who: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ previously had a valid personal beliefs exemption (PBE) filed before 2016 upon entry between TK/kindergarten and 6th grade. These PBEs expire upon entering into 7th grade; and therefore, the student is required to meet the TK/K-12 requirements. ○ are new admissions, including from out-of-state; applies to all grades. <p>Records</p>

- California schools are required to check immunization records for all new student admissions at TK/Kindergarten through 12th grade and all students advancing to 7th grade before entry. Parents must show their child's Immunization Record as proof of immunization.
- Complete a California School Immunization Record (CSIR/Blue Card-BC/CDPH 286, 1/19) for each child. Currently the SFDPH does not have in stock hard copies of the BC, January 2019, but you may print it out, blue color paper is not required, to download it, please click on: <http://eziz.org/assets/docs/shotsforschool/CDPH-286.pdf>.
