



APPROPRIATE USE and ORDERING OF HAND SANITIZER AT SCHOOL

- WHAT** Frequent hand washing with soap and water is recommended to control the transmission of germs in the classroom. However, if soap and water is not available, an alcohol-based hand sanitizer can be used.
- WHO** School staff must supervise the use of sanitizer by students. Hand sanitizer should be kept out of reach of children especially in Child Development Centers and elementary schools.
- WHY** Due to the large amount of alcohol in hand sanitizer, ingestion can lead to intoxication. If hand sanitizer is ingested, call POISON CONTROL: 1-800-222-1222.
- HOW** Hand sanitizer wipes can be ordered from the SFUSD warehouse:
