NURSE OF THE DAY

Every school should have access to current health information.

Historical Background

The Nurse of the Day Program began in 1991. Many schools in SFUSD do not have a school nurse and would otherwise not have access to current, reliable health information.

What is the Nurse of the Day Program?

The Nurse of the Day (NOD) Program has consistently provided health and crisis response and consultation to *ALL* schools, parent/guardians and staff in the SFUSD, as well as community-based organizations. The program also helps to disseminate health information to schools and develops protocols for managing health issues that are commonly seen in schools. The Nurse of the Day program is located at School Health Programs and is staffed by centrally-assigned School District Nurses.

What is the Goal of the Program?

The Nurse of the Day (NOD) program is dedicated to providing timely responses, current health information and guidance to San Francisco Unified School District students, employees, parents/caregivers and community-based organizations.

Current Status

The program is in operation from 8:30am-4pm, Monday-Friday (excluding holidays and breaks) during the regular school year.
